The Credit Hour System" It is a system based on the chosen hours as a unit of study to determine the weight of the course, as it requires the student to complete the number of credit hours according to the specialization system in which he is studying for a bachelor's degree. The credit hours system enables students to study the requirements of the university and college compulsory and elective in all years of study, and in case of failure of the student in an actual compulsory subject to be returned, but if he failed in the elective course, he must either re-study or replace it with another course.

The academic year consists of three courses, the first and second courses of 15 weeks each, while the third summer course is an intensive course of eight weeks .
