

The key Objective of this study is

- To have a briefing on the history of architecture in Mosul Old City, to understand heritage value of traditional buildings and what criteria should be used to assess and evaluate traditional buildings and houses.
- To offer a method for dividing buildings and houses in couple of groups according to their typology, heritage value, age, their use etc.


MOC places, structures, buildings and other features are comprised in the criteria for assessment of cultural heritage to guarantee they are dependably evaluated and managed.

A historic place of MOC may enter the Heritage List if it is satisfied that it has Aesthetic, Archaeological, Architectural, Cultural, Historical, Scientific, Social, Spiritual, Technological or Traditional significance or value.

Any place owns one of these values is significant due to the worth of its involvement in the developing pattern of the cultural history

Each criterion has distinct interpretation in significance assessments.

Based on the local situation of MOC, Criteria and Threshold for inclusion are adapted from the worldwide cases and will be utilized to establish the cultural significance of the place of MOC, as following:
