

Description of the Department of Management Information Systems

About the department The Management Information Systems major is one of the modern and renewable scientific disciplines in the College of Administration and Economics, which was established in accordance with developments in administrative and functional concepts. The Department of Management Information Systems was established in the academic year 2002/2003 and the department started its work as one of the departments in the College of Administration and Economics on 06/15/2002. Where the department provides an integrated annual study plan consisting of (98) credit hours, and the school system has been transferred from the annual system to the courses system in the academic year 2020-2021, which includes study materials in various fields at the college and department levels, and thus the department grants a bachelor's degree in a specialization Management information systems. Therefore, the study plan has been carefully designed to provide graduates with the knowledge and technical and managerial skills necessary to analyze, design, implement and manage information systems in organizations.

The graduate of this department is distinguished by the combination of administrative and technical background, which gives the graduate the ability to achieve better employment of technologies in various fields of administrative sciences. In order to achieve this, computer laboratories have been established, which are used to teach information technology applications, office automation systems, the necessary programming languages, databases, electronic communications and networks, and so on, to provide students with the necessary skills.

The number of faculty members is (26) with doctorate and master's degrees from Iraqi and foreign universities. Graduated from the department (15) courses for bachelor's degree holders, (8) courses for master's degree holders, and (7) courses for holders of a specialized higher diploma in business information technology.
