

A historical overview of the Accounting Department

The Accounting Department was established in the academic year 1985–1986. The aim was to graduate professionally qualified personnel in the field of accounting and auditing equipped with accounting knowledge, so that they could enable them to deal with various accounting problems. To provide an opportunity for employees of state departments and others who want to complete their study, the evening study in the department was opened in the academic year of 1996–1997.

The department's mission is to graduate distinguished students who possess high theoretical and practical accounting skills in order to supply the labor market with professional competencies. Also, to contribute to the formation and development of intellectual capital and paying attention to the quality of the inputs and outputs of the learning process and various research activities.

The department offers the following study programs:

- 1– Bachelor's degree in Accounting Sciences for both studies (morning and evening)
- 2– Higher specialized diploma in accounting (Audit and review of accounts, government budgets)
- 3– Master of Accounting Sciences (Financial Accounting and Auditing, Cost Accounting)
- 4– Doctor of Philosophy in Accounting
