Introduction:

Program Vision: An ambitious vision for the future of the academic program to be advanced, inspiring, motivating, realistic and applicable

Program mission: Briefly defines the goals and activities necessary to achieve them and outlines the paths and directions for program development

Program objectives: These are statements that describe what the academic program intends to achieve within a specific time period and can be measured and observed

Curriculum structure: All courses/materials included in the academic program according to the approved learning system (semester, yearly, Bologna process) whether required (Ministry, University, College, Scientific Department) with the number of credit hours

Learning outcomes: A consistent set of knowledge, skills, and values that students acquire after successfully completing the academic program. The learning outcomes for each course must be defined in a way that achieves the program's objectives

Teaching and learning strategies are the strategies used by faculty members to enhance student teaching and learning; they are the plans followed to achieve learning objectives. They describe all classroom and extracurricular activities designed to achieve the program's learning outcomes


