Publication Requirements

- Participation is open to all researchers, faculty members, and graduate students in person and online.
- Co-author research submissions are accepted, with a maximum of two researchers per paper.
- Submitted research must be original and must not have been previously published or submitted elsewhere. By submitting, the author(s) implicitly and explicitly affirm the originality of their work and assume full responsibility for it.
- Research papers must align with one of the conference's themes.
- An abstract in Arabic and English, French, or Turkish must be submitted, accompanied by at least five keywords.
- An abstract should be between 150–350 words.

- The journal follows APA style for bibliographic references. Footnotes should be placed at the bottom of the page and all cited sources must be translated into English and listed alphabetically at the end of the paper.
- Papers may be submitted in Arabic, English,
 French, or Turkish.

Formatting Guidelines

- Main text font size 14
- Footnotes font size 10
- Font type: Times New Roman
- The paper must include detailed author information (full name, academic title, workplace, city, country, and ORCID number).
- Accepted papers will be published in a special issue of Adab Al-Rafidain Journal, affiliated with the College of Arts.
- Papers must comply with academic research standards and be uploaded to the journal's platform: [https://radab.uomosul.edu.iq] (https://radab.uomosul.edu.iq). Authors must commit to completing the publication process, adhering to reviewers' feedback, and making required revisions.
- The conference committee will coordinate with international publishers and journals for those wishing to publish their work elsewhere, subject to additional fees (to be agreed upon later).
