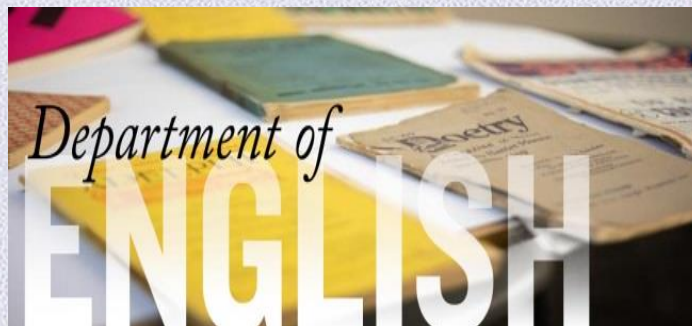
Historical Background
