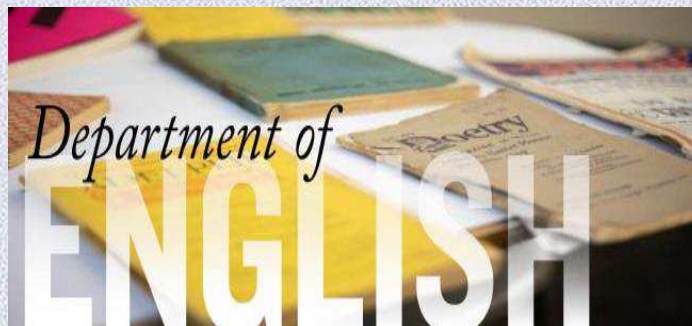
Historical Background

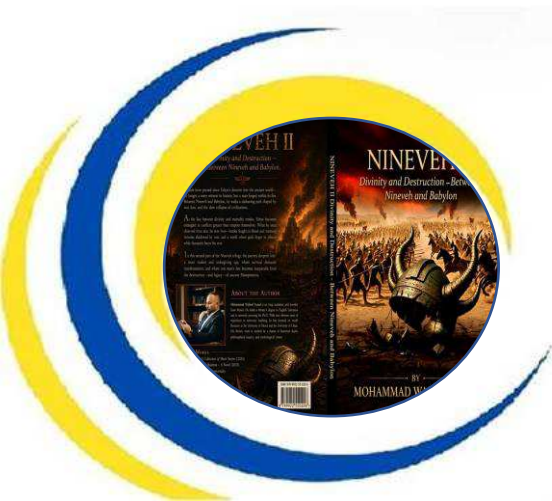
