Implementation Steps of "My School"

Fieldwork Actions

-  **Book Collection & Donation:** Organized an internal book drive with active participation from faculty and students, cataloging cultural and educational sources for distribution to school libraries.
-  **Field Visits & Guidance:** Department faculty and student delegations visited schools to offer organizational and administrative guidance for library management and cataloging.
-  **Interactive Student Workshops:** Conducted short reading sessions and awareness activities encouraging pupils to embrace reading and reduce screen time.
