Encouraging pupils and young adults in local neighborhoods to engage in extracurricular reading and build self-learning skills.

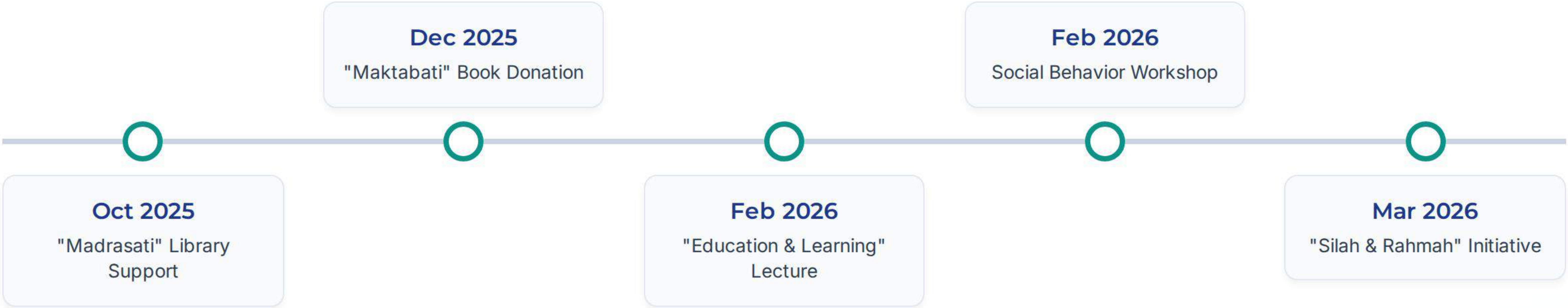


Voluntary Action
