Zafia **almost always** checks her email first thing in the morning.

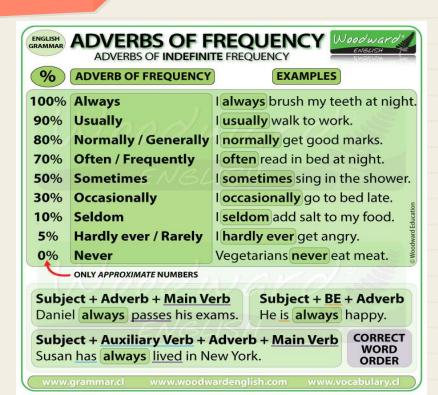
I have to call a support technician occasionally.

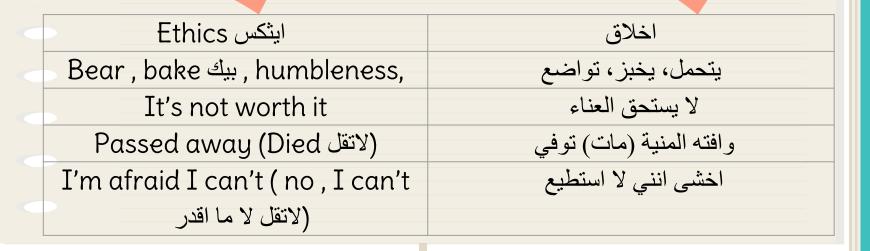
