

B: Good question! We have a product launch tomorrow night. _____ (want/come)?

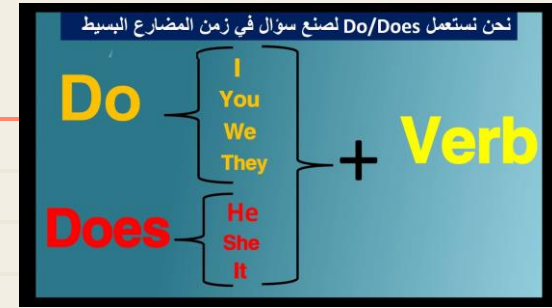

Present simple questions



To form **present simple questions**, we use **do/does + subject + main verb**. If there is a question word (**who, what, when, where, how**, ... etc.), it always comes at the beginning.

Does this software **work** on iPhones?

How often **do** you **update** the software?

For **Yes/No** questions (questions we can answer with 'yes' or 'no'), we use rising intonation (↑).
For questions that begin with a question word, we use falling intonation (↓).

How do I use this software? (↓)
