An overview of the private law branch

□ The private law branch was established in the academic year (1993-1994) and is concerned with teaching students the laws that govern the legal relationship in which the state enters, not in its capacity as the holder of sovereignty and authority, based on the traditional division of law. The branch includes specializations (civil law, commercial law, the law of proceedings and evidence). Personal status law, private .international law

□ The private law branch grants doctorate, master's, and higher diploma degrees, in its various precise specializations

□ The branch has many scientific, cultural, and community service activities, both actual and virtual, as the branch held many scientific seminars, workshops, dozens of discussion circles, and many initiatives in .community service
