The College of Law is one of the most prominent humanities colleges at the University of Mosul. It was established in the academic year 1983-1984, and it was called the College of Law. The Department of Politics was created there and it was called the College of Law and Politics. As a result of the Politics Department joining the College of Political Sciences that was created at that time, the previous name was returned to it (College of Law) with one scientific department, the Department of Law. In the academic year 1993-1994, the single scientific department split into two scientific branches: the Public Law Branch and the Private Law Branch. In 2008, the name of the College was hanged from the College of Law to the College of Law, and a third scientific branch was established. In the name of the Human Rights Law Branch, the College of Law is the first law college among the corresponding colleges in Catar's universities to establish this branch, which was established in the year 2012
