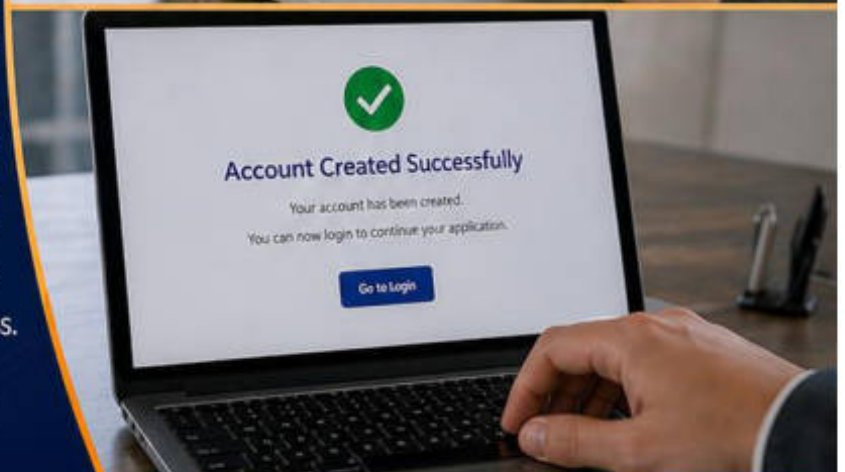
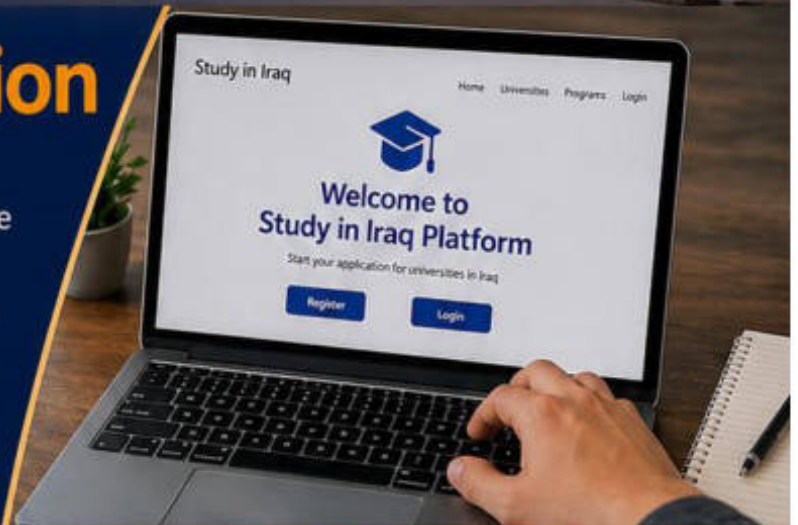
Applicants are required to complete the application process through the official Study in Iraq platform. The process begins by creating a personal account, which allows applicants to access the application system and track their submission.



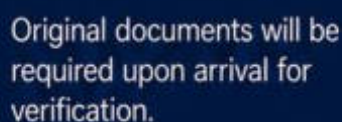
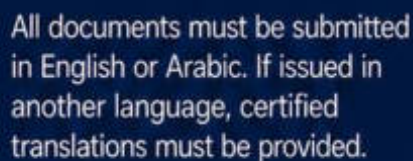
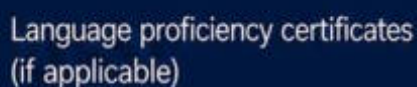
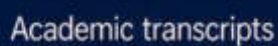
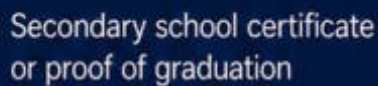
After registration, applicants must fill in the online application form with accurate personal, academic, and contact information. It is essential to ensure that all data provided is correct and consistent with official documents.

Admission and Registration

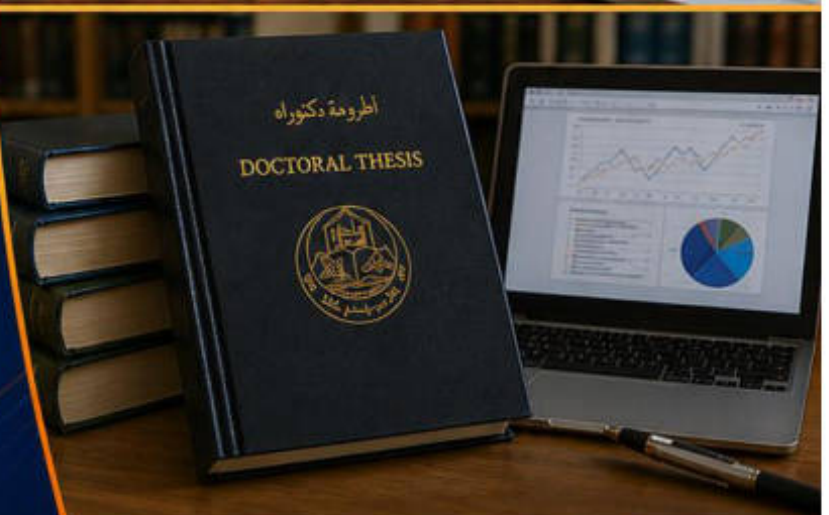
UOM verifies and authenticates all submitted academic certificates and supporting documents to ensure applicants meet the required academic standards. Admission decisions are issued in batches, and applicants will be notified through the official platform.

Upon receiving the admission letter, students must prepare for registration at the university. Registration typically takes place before the beginning of the academic year.

Students must bring original documents, including:

- Passport
- Admission letter
- Academic certificates
- Visa documentation

Failure to provide required documents may result in cancellation of admission.



Programs Studies at UOM

UOM offers a diverse range of postgraduate programs designed to meet the needs of students seeking advanced knowledge and specialized expertise. These programs are structured into three main levels, providing flexible academic pathways for both local and international students.



1. Higher Diploma (Postgraduate Diploma)

This program typically spans one academic year and focuses on professional and applied knowledge. It is designed for students seeking practical skills or specialization without committing to long-term research.



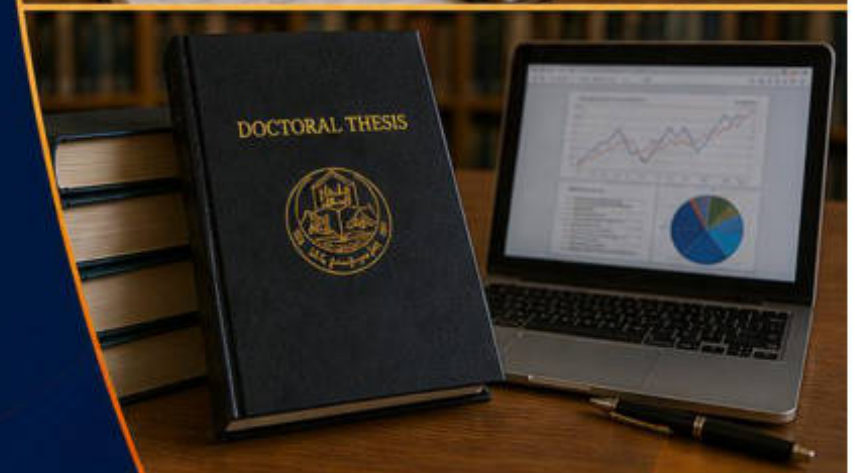
2. Master's Degree (MSc / MA)

These programs typically span two academic years, combining coursework with research components. Students complete advanced theoretical modules followed by a supervised research thesis.



3. Doctoral Degree (PhD)

Doctoral programs focus on independent research and scientific contribution. Students produce original research that advances knowledge in their field.

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RESEARCH & STUDENT LIFE



Postgraduate students at UOM benefit from a vibrant academic and research environment that aligns with the objectives of the Study in Iraq program. The university actively promotes innovation, scientific research, and international academic collaboration.



Students are encouraged to participate in research projects, scientific conferences, workshops, and academic publishing, allowing them to develop advanced research skills and contribute to knowledge production at both local and global levels.



In addition to academic excellence, UOM provides a comprehensive student experience through well-equipped libraries, modern study spaces, and dedicated academic support services. These facilities are designed to enhance both academic performance and personal development, ensuring a balanced and enriching postgraduate journey.



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TUITION & FINANCIAL SUPPORT

UOM, under the Study in Iraq program, offers flexible financial options for international postgraduate students, allowing them to pursue their studies under different funding schemes:



◆ Fully Funded Scholarships

Students admitted under this category are exempt from paying tuition fees. These scholarships are granted based on specific criteria and provide full financial coverage for academic study.



◆ Partially Funded Scholarships (50% Tuition)

Students are required to pay only 50% of the tuition fees.

The remaining portion is covered under the scholarship scheme. Fees are determined based on:

- The level of study
- The required academic qualification
- The type of institution (public or private)

Payments are typically made annually in Iraqi Dinar or its equivalent in US Dollars, as specified in official guidelines.



◆ Self-Funded Students

Students in this category are responsible for paying full tuition fees as set by the university. Fees vary depending on the program and institution and are paid annually in Iraqi Dinar or equivalent foreign currency.
