

Present continuous tense

The present continuous is made from the present tense of the verb be and the –ing form of a verb: The present continuous verb tense indicates that an action or condition is happening now, frequently, and may continue into the future.

The Present Continuous Formula: to be [am, is, are] + verb [present participle]

I am	working
You are	playing
He is	talking
She is	living
It is	eating
We are	staying
They are	sleeping

Stative verbs

We do not normally use the continuous **with stative verbs**. Stative verbs include:

- verbs of **thinking and feeling**:

<i>believe</i>	<i>love</i>	<i>recognize</i>
<i>dislike</i>	<i>hate</i>	<i>remember</i>
<i>know</i>	<i>prefer</i>	<i>suppose</i>
<i>like</i>	<i>realize</i>	<i>think (= believe)</i>

- verbs of **the senses**:

<i>appear</i>	<i>look</i>	<i>smell</i>
<i>feel</i>	<i>seem</i>	<i>sound</i>
		<i>taste</i>

Others

<i>agree</i> <i>be</i>	<i>belong</i> <i>disagree</i>	<i>need</i> <i>owe</i>	<i>own</i> <i>possess</i>
---------------------------	----------------------------------	---------------------------	------------------------------

We normally use the simple instead:

I understand you. (NOT *I ~~am understanding~~ you.*)

This cake tastes wonderful. (NOT *This cake ~~is tasting~~ wonderful.*)

uses

- To describe an action that is going on at this moment:

Ex: You are using the Internet. / You are studying English grammar.

- To describe an action or event in the future, which has already been planned or prepared:

Ex: We're going on holiday tomorrow.

Ex: I'm meeting my boyfriend tonight.

Ex: Are they visiting you next winter?

Ex: He is going to visit his grandpa

- To describe a temporary event or situation:

Ex: He usually plays the drums, but he's playing bass guitar tonight.

Ex: The weather forecast was good, but it's raining at the moment.

- with "always, forever, constantly", to describe and emphasis a continuing series of repeated actions:

ex: Harry and Sally are always arguing!

Ex: You're constantly / usually complaining about your mother-in-law !
