

First International Conference on Petroleum and Mining Engineering (FCPME)

Instructions for Contributors of Scientific Papers

1. Authors are required to submit the abstract that falls within the scope of Petroleum and Mining Engineering and its related scientific and industrial applications.
2. **The abstract must be prepared in Microsoft Word format (Times New Roman, font size 12) and submitted electronically to the official conference e-mail address: pe.conference2025@uomosul.edu.iq, no later than 31 December 2025.**
3. The abstract should not exceed one page (approximately 350 words) and must include the paper title ; name(s) of author(s); academic degree(s); institutional affiliation(s); e-mail address and phone number of the corresponding author; and a brief summary of the corresponding author's curriculum vitae.
4. Scientific presentations may be submitted in Arabic and/or English, subject to linguistic accuracy and scientific reviewer.
5. All submitted abstracts will be subject to scientific review and evaluation by the Scientific Committee to determine their suitability for oral presentation at the conference.
6. The abstract must reflect original research that contributes to scientific knowledge and must not have been previously published or presented. Research derived from M.Sc. or Ph.D. theses must be clearly acknowledged.
7. Abstracts accepted for oral presentation will be published in the official Abstract Volume, distributed to registered participants, published on the conference website, and circulated to relevant governmental institutions.
8. Full-text papers accepted for oral presentation will be published in a special volume issued by the designated publishing body (to be announced).
9. Acceptance of an abstract for oral presentation does not necessarily imply acceptance of the corresponding full-text paper for journal publication. All submitted manuscripts will undergo scientific peer review.
