


Diagnosis: Focal interstitial nephritis


Organ: Kidney


Lesion:

- 1. Presence of inflammatory foci represent the aggregation of lymphocytes in the cortex in addition to the dilation of renal tubules.
- 2. These aggregations are under the cortex and it is known as white spotted kidney attributed to its grossly appearance.











Diagnosis: Embolic Suppurative Nephritis


Organ: Kidney


Lesion:

- 1. Suppurative inflammation in renal tubules especially near the renal glomeruli
- 2. Large numbers of inflammatory cells around the pus in the interstitial tissue forming the line of demarcation









Diagnosis: Cystic kidney

Organ: Kidney

Lesion:

1. Presence of cysts in the renal tissue (polycystic kidney).

- 2. The wall of cyst is lined by flattened epithelium.
- 3. Presence of hyaline casts in the form of pink masses in the lumen of tubules.
- 4. Infiltration of inflammatory cells in the wall of cysts in the renal tissue.
