Pubis:

The pubis is L_shaped and consists of body or acetabular branch and symphysial branch, the cranial border of the body is the pectin of the pubis and forms the iliopubic eminence. On the ventral surface of the pubic symphysis protrudes the ventral pubic tubercle.
