**Summary:** Medicines are chemical substances given to animals either to treat diseases or to prevent them. They are formulated in various forms to match the needs of the animal and the type of illness being addressed. Additionally, drugs can be administered through several different routes, depending on the condition and the most effective method for delivering the medication.

### **Types of injections:**

- 1- Intra - uterine injection i/u.
- 2- Intra - mammary injection.
- 3- Intra - venous injection i/v.
- 4- Intra - muscular injection i/m.
- 5- Intra - dermal injection lid.
- 6- subcutaneous injection s.c.
- 7- Intra - ruminal injection
- 8- Intra - spinal injection
- 9- Intra - tracheal injection
